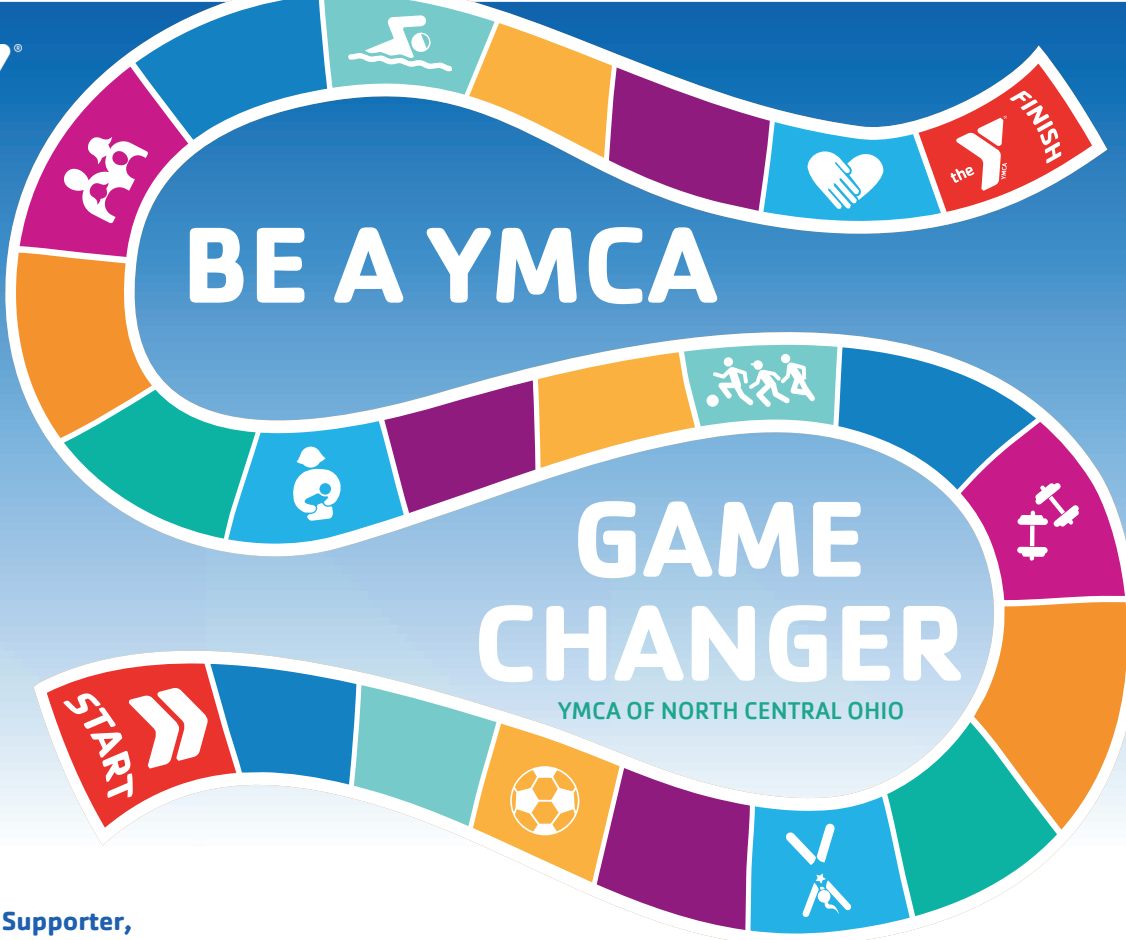

Dear YMCA Supporter,

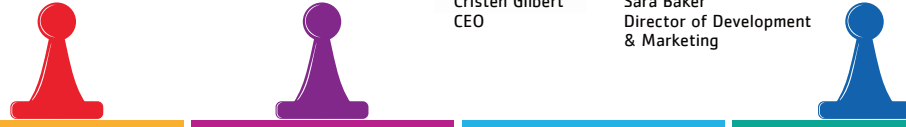

457 families awarded Open Door Financial Assistance Scholarships
